THE SOLEMNITY of the SACRED HEART of JESUS: This year is the fiftieth anniversary of the building of our Church in Tenbury. The Archbishop will be the Principal Celebrant at a Mass of Thanksgiving on FRIDAY JUNE 7th at 7 pm and ALL OUR PARISHIONERS (from both Communities) are warmly invited to celebrate this significant occasion. After Mass the Archbishop will bless two memorial plaques which will be place in our Church: to commemorate FR JOHN DANAHER, who, as Parish Priest of Stourport was responsible for the building of the Church; and MARTIN HOMER, a potter who was also a parishioner, and sculpted our very fine Stations of the Cross. Martin died in July 2023 and the plaques are the work of his son, Benedict. St Ambrose's parishioners who will be attending are invited to bring a small contribution for the buffet supper in the Church grounds after Mass (imaginative salads, savouries and puddings!).
