Any number of volunteers are welcome to join in – particularly those with previous experience in decoration, plastering and other useful skills. Volunteers are welcome at any time convenient to themselves, though all will need to work to Patryk's specifications and under his direction. This is an extremely generous offer on his part. We ask anyone willing to take part to make themselves known to the Parish Priest during the next couple of weeks. We shall then arrange a briefing session with Patryk and we hope to begin work during the summer months.
