LITURGY, PRAYER and DEVOTION; EVANGELISATION & MISSION, PASTORAL CARE; ADMINISTRATION. Lists of contacts are being compiled and representatives of these areas will be consulting with the Parish Priest to co-ordinate the relevant activities. We refer our parishioners to the FACEBOOK PAGE (St Ambrose Church Kidderminster); we will be establishing a WHATS APP Group, and our website is to be updated and revised. In all the areas listed above there are sub-groups (eg PASTORAL CARE will include safeguarding, SVP, Companions, Pro-Life, Parents & Toddlers etc.) and together we hope to sustain the groups that are already established, and recognise any other immediate needs. It was agreed that the preference is for A PARISH IN COUNCIL rather than a PARISH COUNCIL. This will enable ALL parishioners to be involved in our planning and decision making. Also, it was established that, in the event of pastoral cover for weekend Masses being unavailable (in sudden illness or even holiday times) a list of Mass times in our area should always be available in case Mass in our Churches is not possible. It was thought that expecting elderly clergy to be trying to cover several Churches, as well as their own, is unreasonable. It was heartening to hear so much constructive advice, and I hope for continuing co-operation as we seek to lay the groundwork for the future.
